Hospice Provider Member Rates

Provider member dues for 2022 are based on the number of patients your program served in 2020. The cost of membership is \$8.75 per patient served, plus a base membership rate of \$250. The current cap for dues payments is \$9,000 for organizations that served fewer than 2,000 patients in 2020 and \$11,000 for organizations that served more than 2,000.
